

RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING DOCKAGE

The following rules and regulations must be followed by the owner, crew, and guests of all vessels utilizing the Harbor House Marina. Your cooperation observing these rules and regulations is appreciated.

1. Harbor House Marina is a private berthing area. Vessel must obtain reservations prior to entering marina. Vessels found illegally docked will be fined. Harbor House Marina/GPM Inc. reserves the right to hire a private marine towing company to remove said vessel at vessel owner's expense.
2. Only vessels in good condition, and under their own power, will be admitted into the marina. If there is an emergency during vessel owners absence, i.e. breakdown of bilge pump(s), leak, broken dock lines, Harbor House Marina/GPM Inc. is authorized to make such repairs as it deems necessary. Repair cost will be charged to the vessel owner.
3. All vessels in or approaching the Harbor House Marina must apply and follow all Navigation Laws of the United States, i.e. "Rules of the Road".
4. Noise must be kept to a minimum at all times. Marina patrons must use discretion when operating engines, generators, radios, televisions. The use of mechanical tools outside a vessel is prohibited, i.e. buffers, sanders, rug cleaners, compressors, etc.
5. NO vessel shall discharge waste, oil, fuel, or refuse while docked at the Harbor House Marina. Persons found not observing the "no discharge" rule will be immediately dismissed from the marina and the U.S Coast Guard will be notified.
6. Pets must be leashed at ALL times.
7. Children must be under direct adult supervision.
8. Harbor House Marina reserves the right to change confirmed slip assignments. At the discretion of the harbormaster, slip assignments will be finalized upon day of arrival.
9. Checkout time is 12:00pm. Check in will be anytime after 1:00pm. Upon arrival marina patrons are requested to check in immediately. Patrons must notify harbormaster when vacating slip at anytime, i.e. day sail, fishing, cruise.
10. Marina patrons shall not store supplies, materials, accessories, bikes, or debris on dock. Please keep the walkways clear.
11. Laundry may not be hung on boats, docks, or any area surrounding marina.
12. Dinghies and other small boats must be stored aboard or, if available, in a space assigned by the harbormaster.
13. Harbor House Marina/GPM Inc. reserves the right to dismiss any vessel from dockage due to insubordination of all said rules and regulations.
